## MINUTES – Regular Meeting April 25, 2016 - before Town Meeting

Pursuant to notice April 25, 2016 at the Middle School Media Center at 6:30 PM

### 1. School Committee Reorganization

Mrs. Tremblay called the meeting to order and requested nominations for School Committee Chairman.

Mrs. Presser nominated Mr. Doyle as Chairman. Dr. Cammarata seconded the motion.

VOTED: Unanimously in favor

Mr. Doyle appointment Mrs. Presser as Vice-Chairman noting that they have worked very well together for 14 years.

Others Present: Mrs. Tremblay, Mrs. Vernon , 2 members of the press and Mr. Geary

Mr. Doyle thanked the Committee and introduced Rich Sjoberg as their new member.

### 2. FY 16 Budget Update

Mr. Geary presented a FY 16 Budget Update to the Committee. He stated that at  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the year, we are in good shape. The \$550,000 Capital budget has funded the central office move, security cameras, and technology very successfully. We will be returning to the Town \$70,000 from preschool tuition. Salary and unemployment have shown a savings. We will again pay in June out-of-placements for the coming year, which has helped us. Transportation and copies are over budget. We now have one vendor for all the copies, which does save us money.

### 3. Superintendent's Report

Mrs. Tremblay reported on the following:

- Mrs. Tremblay elaborated on the security cameras in the buildings. By Thursday, May 5th everything will be working, including positioning of cameras and motion activation 24/7. Cameras are inside and outside the buildings, including the fields and busses, where we use them often. The outside cameras have been upgraded.

Mr. Doyle let the Committee know that Dr. Paul Anderson, who has served as our representative to the North Shore Regional Tech School has resigned after many years of service. Gary Hathaway has been appointed as the new representative. Mrs. Presser indicated that the Committee has voted on the appointment in the past and she suggested to ask Mr. Hathaway to come to the next meeting so the Committee can meet him.

Mrs. Presser MOVED to adjourn the regular meeting. Mr. Hayman seconded the motion.

VOTED: Unanimously in favor

The regular meeting was adjourned at 6:50 PM. The Committee moved on to Town Meeting.
